# CRYING-BOY CURSE STRIKES AGAIN

**BLAZING CURSE OF THE CRYING BOY PICTURE!**



## Print undamaged as family's home burns

**THE curse of a crying boy picture struck again yesterday when a young family's home was destroyed by fire.**

Kevin Godber, 23, and his wife Julie, 19, arrived home to find it wrecked—but found the jinxed picture undamaged.

It was still hanging in the charred ruins of the council house, while other pictures beside it were shriveled and burnt beyond recognition.

By a striking coincidence, the blaze at East Herringthorpe, near Rotherham, South Yorks, happened just miles from the scene of another fire last month in which a crying boy painting survived intact. Since The Sun told the frightening story of that blaze at Swallowstone, horrified readers have reported that they, too, have been victims of the curse.

### Urchins

They all owned prints of weeping urchins, some from a series by Italian artist G. Bragolin.

● A woman in Miteham, Surrey, claimed fire gutted her home, leaving her print undamaged.

● Another woman, in Kilburn, North London, said she and her sister-in-law and a friend had ALL suffered house fires since buying pictures.

A South Yorkshire fire spokesman warned yesterday: "These incidents are becoming more and more frequent. It is strange and we have no logical explanation for it."

Jobless Kevin, whose family were left with just the clothes they were wearing, said yesterday: "We had only been in the house for a few months."

### Left

The picture was already hanging on the wall—it was left behind by the previous tenant.

Fire experts believe the blaze was started by an electric fire in a bedroom. Last night Kevin, Julie, and their two children were staying with friends.

More than 50,000 copies of crying boy prints are thought to have found their way into British homes.
